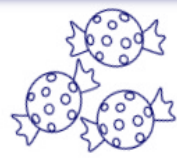




Shoes, feet and all things sweet!



Competition

For this year's competition, you have three options:

Option 1: Colouring competition.

(Suggested for children aged up to 8 / KS1 P4 - but older if you really want!)

Colour in the picture of Jesus washing his disciples' feet. It is downloadable as a separate file, or included as a separate page with the project material.

Option 2: Decorate a shoe.

(All ages - individual entries)

Children may wish to decorate an old shoe (if they don't have any old shoes, they can be picked up quite cheaply from most charity shops). Examples (see pics) - white canvas shoes can be coloured with felt markers; welly-boots can be painted; sandals can be decorated with beads and ribbons; most shoes can have stickers and felt applied - or glue and glitter!

Mix and match these ideas - the only limit is your imagination!



Option 3: Create a poster.

(All ages - suitable as a class project)

Create a poster including information from the project alongside pictures of funny feet or different shoes. Session 3 in the Lesson Plans will give you some ideas for this. This option may require a little technological 'know-how'; but with mobile phones and digital cameras, great things should be possible!

All children who enter will receive a certificate. Please make sure every entry is clearly labelled with name/age/parish (suggest putting labels inside shoes).

Various prizes will be awarded depending on the number & type of entries received.
